



Flow Fests are free access public flow arts festivals taking place in urban parks within major cities across the United States. Each year, hundreds of people attend Flow Fests events to learn and connect- to share in the exchange of skills and talents and expand the local flow arts community. We consider our events as a 'gateway' to the larger flow community and a warm introduction to flow arts gatherings for aspiring professionals, mavens and novice artists alike.

Flow Fests began in 2011 in Lake Worth, FL with Florida Flow Fest and have grown over the years to spread the fun of Flow Arts to the following cities: Asheville, NC (2015-2016); Austin, TX (2015-2019); Chicago (2017-2025); Dallas, TX (2025); Denver (2025) Ft Lauderdale, FL (2018-2025); San Diego, CA (2019); Seattle, WA (2016-2025); St Petersburg, FL (2023).



Florida Flow Fest 2019

Flow Fests are educational festivals- we offer workshops with professional artists, teachers & guides throughout the day. We build the programming for each Flow Fest around the goals and luminaries of each local creative community, tailoring our instructor lineup and workshop offerings to give the people what they want, to the best of our ability.

While each Flow Fest is slightly different, the core components of the event are consistent: Flow Fests are free entry events occurring in publicly accessible spaces offering free introductory workshops in flow arts, dance and yoga. Intermediate and advanced workshops in flow arts, dance and yoga are also available with a paid workshop pass (ranging in price from \$40-80) for participants who are eager to level up in their own flow arts practice. Additionally, Flow Fest presents at least one free public showcase performance per event.





"But any one individual workshop would cost at least \$60," Tanenbaum says.

Among the featured circus arts are "rope dart" and "puppy hammer," both of which are versions of poi, an ancient form of prop manipulation from the Maori traditions of New Zealand. The activities consist of swinging weighted balls on the end of a string or cord in rhythmic patterns.

"Any time you see a photo of fire-dancing or fire-spinning, it's probably a poi artist," Tanenbaum says.

She says this festival is "unparalleled in the community" because it is open to people who aren't familiar with such activities.

"Very few are open to the public," she adds. "They tend to be private affairs on private land available to those who are already doing it. So here you can get into the flow — without being in the know."

Friday is especially valuable to beginners, with entry-level workshops

Grounded in a philosophy that seeks the state of "flow" — defined as "an exhilarating, transcendent way of being in which effortless control and peak skill seem to erase a sense of time" — this year's Flow Fest drew the greatest number yet of acrobatic adepts offering the widest variety of performances: hoops, juggling, fire dance, belly dance, yoga, break dancing, capoeira. It stretched over three days of workshops, and play lasted well into the evening, the better to take in the blazing, twisting, turning array. Darkening skies along the Intracoastal Waterway became an Arabian Nights fantasy, full of fit and youthful forms, in clothes variously medieval, thrift-shop, or psychedelic homespun, capering across the lawn with grace and precision, a temporary village of the body electric. Listen hard enough and you can still hear the temple bells.
